Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,

The Hellenic Air Force Academy under the auspices of the European Security and Defence College, in the framework of the European Initiative for the Exchange of Military Young Officers, inspired by Erasmus, has the honour of organising for the first time the Common Module on Unmanned Aerial Systems (UASs) since they provide a key capability in today's constantly developing operational environment.

In the last decade Unmanned Aerial Systems have experienced significant growth, mainly due to the rapid technological development, increasing sharply the interest for their utilization in a number of everyday applications, especially in the Security and Defence field. The major goals of this module is to provide the participants with a general overview on the basic principles of the technologies supporting UAS and their applications, specification of different UAS categories, types and sensors used for civilian and military applications and different perspectives for integrating UAS to European "Common Security and Defence Policy" missions.

The module consists of an **e-Learning part**, as well as a **residential session**, hold at Athens, at the premises of the Hellenic Air Force Academy in Dekeleia Air Force Base, **from 14 to 18 of February 2022, both parts being compulsory.**
